Ben Shedd showed his Academy Award Winning documentary, "[The Flight of the Gossamer Condor](#)". The film told the story about history's first successful human powered airplane - designed by inventor Dr. Paul MacCready and his team from Aerovironment, Inc., and flown by pilot Bryan Allen. The Gossamer Condor airplane won 50,000 pounds, that is equivalent to \$100,000.00. Today, the Gossamer Condor aircraft is on display in the Smithsonian Institution National Air and Space Museum in Washington DC, where it hangs in an honored place beside the Wright Brothers first airplane and the Apollo 11 moon capsule. Ben Shedd is an Academy Award winning filmmaker. He has produced a number of shows for NOVA, and several IMAX and OMNIMAX science films. Ben has been invited by EAA to Air Venture 2008 to show his newly remastered 30th Anniversary DVD of the film. Many members gave Ben ideas and asked questions to help him prepare for his trip to Oshkosh.
